

Key Stage 2 (KS2) Results 2016 - (Inc. SATS Results)

Pupils who sat the End of Key Stage Two tests (SATS) were allocated a scaled score within the three key areas that were tested. A scaled score of 100 indicates that a child is working at Age expected levels. Although 0% of pupils achieved this, there were pupils who achieved scores only just below this scaled score of 100.

Within Reading, scaled scores ranged from 85 to 98

Within Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling, scaled scores ranged from 82 to 90

Within Maths, scaled scores for all pupils were valued as 80.

(The pupil who attained a scaled score of 98 within reading began KS2 still working on the P Scales within this strand - indicating the outstanding progress made during KS2)
