#### **Lower School**

In Lower School we have finished learning all about the senses in science. The 18th October 2019

children have all taken part in a range of sensory experiments to guess the object by it's smell, taste and feel! Everyone did really well trying new foods and being brave; touching things they couldn't see. During our 'all about me' topic each class has made a display with all pupils contributing to the creation!



Each pupil has also learnt about their school and which class they belong to. Each pupil made their own mini model of a pupil wearing the Middleton uniform - complete with kingfisher!

#### Middle School

Middle School have been busy exploring both 2D and 3D shapes. All of the children have enjoyed the story of the 'Monkey Puzzle' and learnt the Makaton signs to support the story.



Within cooking, the children have made fairy cakes, which you may have sampled at home! The PE lessons have focused upon safe use of the apparatus, and the children have explored

their feelings through the medium of dance!

#### **Upper School**

Upper School pupils have been constructing bridges in Design technology! They have considered if they are for pedestrians or vehicles and the properties of the materials used to construct.



In Geography they have been considering the effects of plastic upon the environment, and also considering how we can reuse plastic more effectively.

In RE the pupils have explored a range of religious creation stories.

In PE the pupils learnt how to change direction while moving along a piece of apparatus! Good balance required!
