

Year Six Reading Attainment

At Middleton School, we aim to raise attainment within reading so that as many pupils as possible transition from KS2 to KS3 as M9 readers or above.

In July 2019, nine out of the 13 pupils (70%) in year six had acquired an attainment of M9 or above. Of the four pupils who did not reach this attainment, three of them attained a level of M8A, therefore on the cusp of attaining an M9 grade!

Comparisons with data from previous cohorts (bearing in mind that a different assessment tool was introduced for the 2018 cohort) are as follows:

The results demonstrate an improvement on the attainment of the 2018 cohort, with a higher percentage of pupils attaining M9 or above (70%).
