Make a Bird Feeder with Mrs Want



What you need:



Juice or milk carton (washed out)
Scissors
Sponge or Paint Brush
Acrylic Paint or Twigs
PVA Glue
String or Ribbon
Items to decorate your Bird Feeder (leaves, twigs, foam shapes) Please do not use glitter as it can make the birds poorly if they eat it.





On the front and the back of the carton draw a section to cut out for the birds to sit in your feeder. Cut this shape out with the help of an adult.





Using your sponge or brush paint the carton. You may need to wait for it to dry after you have painted it once and paint it again. It does not matter if you do not cover all the words on the carton.

If you are not using paint you can go to the next step below.







Decorate your Bird Feeder.
I used twigs and foam shapes.





Cut ribbon or string to approx 40 cm. An adult may need to help at this stage.

Place the two ends in the carton top. Secure by screwing the lid back on.



Fill your bird feeder with bird seed and hang outside.
