

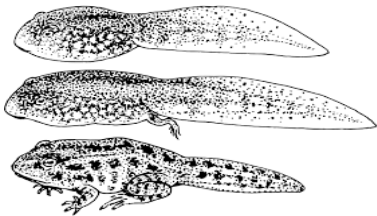
The life cycle of a frog

The frog has four stages of its life cycle.

1. The first stage is an egg. This is called frogspawn; they are laid in or near water.



2. The second stage is a Tadpole hatches from the egg.



3. The third stage is the froglet. Lungs and legs begin to grow. This is called Metamorphosis.

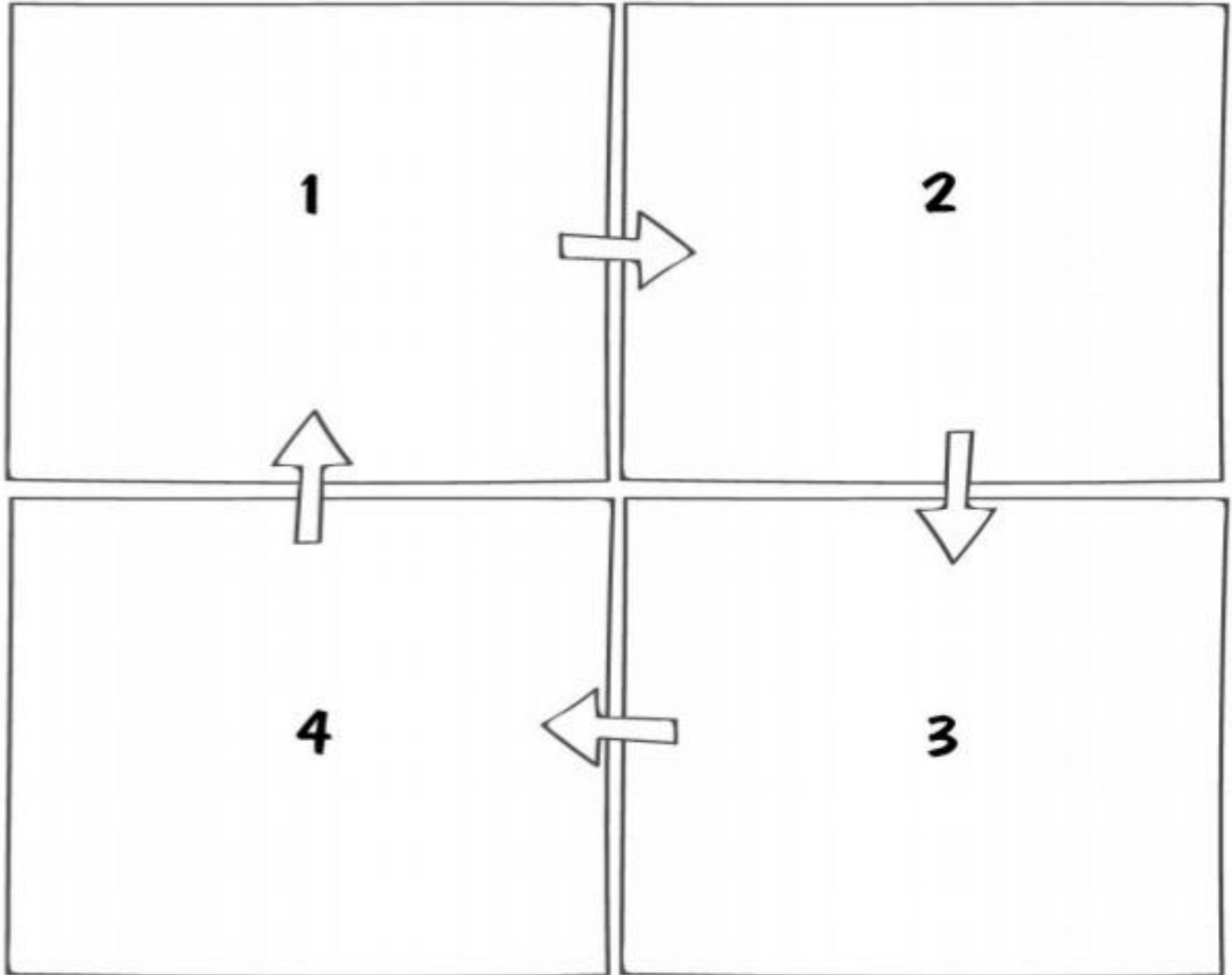
4. The fourth and last stage is the adult; the Tadpole is now a frog.
