The pupils have also created their own seaside paintings.



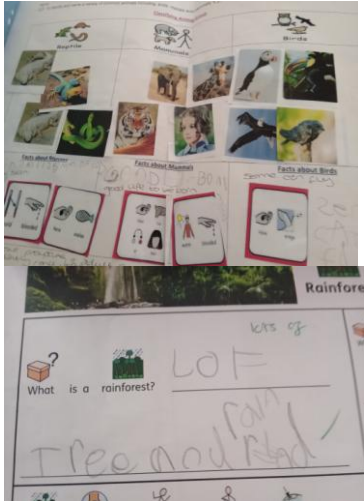
This week they have read the story 'we're going on a treasure hunt' and made strawberry cheesecake in cooking lessons.
