Transition day was a success. The children all had a lovely morning in their new classroom. It was also lovely to welcome our new starters to Middleton School.



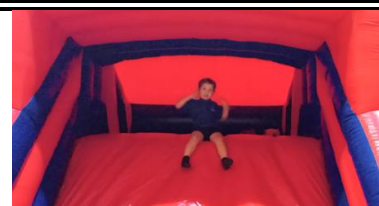
